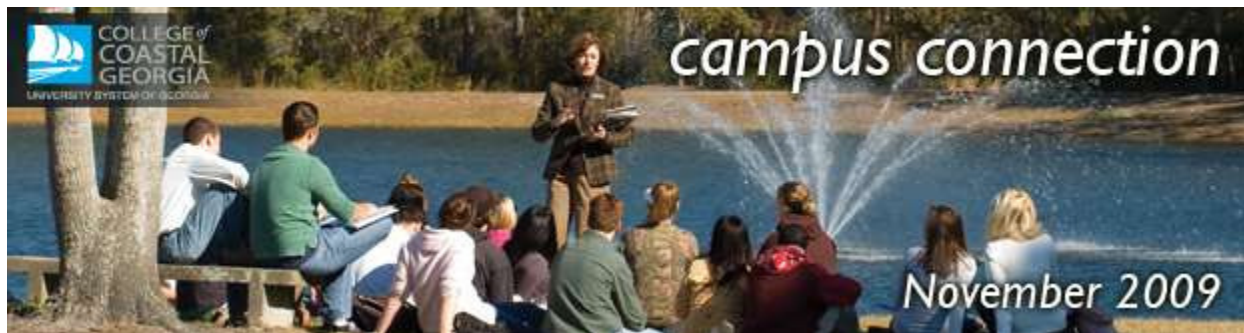

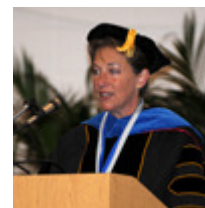

All came to support and recognize Valerie Hepburn in her inauguration celebration as president of College of Coastal Georgia.

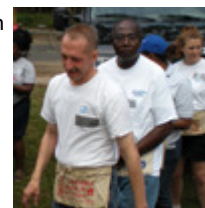

Take a Stroll Downtown November 6th

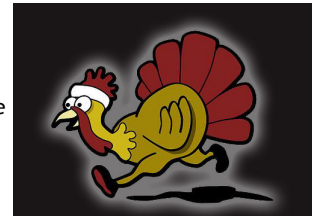
