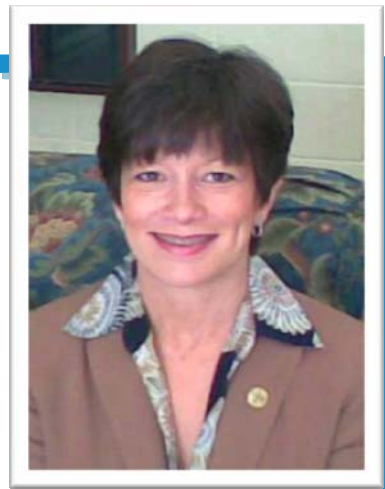


Welcome Cynthia Atwood, Asst. VP of Planning & Risk Management
