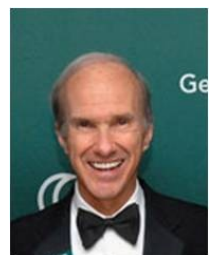

Dr. Daniel J. Kaufman is first speaker for College of Coastal Georgia lecture series

The College of Coastal Georgia is pleased to announce the lecture series *Transforming the College: Lessons from Leaders* in the Thomas Auditorium at the Southeast Georgia Conference Center. The first of the monthly lectures will be held Friday, January 23, 2009 at 2:00 p.m. Guest speaker is Dr. Daniel Kaufman, President of Georgia Gwinnett College, lecturing on *Innovation, Creativity and Inspiration: Building the Campus of Tomorrow*.

Dr. Kaufman is a native of Brunswick and graduate of West Point, Harvard and MIT. He was the chief academic officer at West Point until 2005, when he returned to Georgia to become the charter president of Georgia Gwinnett College, the first new four year college in Georgia in over 100 years. Dr. Kaufman will share leadership lessons from his military service and academic career
