Background Research

- An estimated 10 million animals die from abuse or cruelty every year in the U.S. (Animal Shelter Count The National Database)
- Nearly 400,000 dogs that enter shelters across the country are euthanized annually. (ASCTND)
- An estimated 10,000 puppy mills exist in the country (ASCTND)
- About 250,000 animals annually are found to be victims of animal hoarding , with most living in unsanitary conditions. (ASCTND)
